What is the volume of water in the two bottles?

3. A tank had 78L of brown liquid. On Monday, 24L was used up. On Tuesday, another 17L was used up. How much brown liquid was left in the tank?

4. Holly has three pails.
Pail A holds 25L of water.
Pail B holds 8L of water less than Pail A.
Pail C holds 15L of water more than Pail B.
What is the volume of water in Pail C?
